



MONITOR PROGRAM

Deadline: September 1, 2011

Monitors are responsible for assisting the instructor, including studio set up, and are expected to be familiar with the general technical requirements of their particular studio. Monitors are also workshop participants and will have ample time for personal work.

GOALS

1. To provide faculty with an assistant
2. To provide North Country Studio Workshops with a communication link to the workshop

BENEFIT

Successful applicants will receive a tuition discount of \$125.

DUTIES

1. Arrive the day before the Workshops to help with the workshop set-up and stay 1 hour after lunch at end of Workshops to help with general break down
2. Help faculty settle into dorm
3. Act as liaison between faculty and North Country Studio Workshops
4. Attend daily lunch meetings
5. Make class announcements and collect materials fees
6. Organize studio clean-up

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Must be a team player, willing to help where needed
2. Must have experience in the workshop medium
3. Experience as a Monitor is helpful
4. Prior attendance at North Country Studio Workshops is helpful

PROCESS - *This is a two-part process.*

1. In order to apply for a monitor position, applicants must first register for a workshop by mailing or faxing their North Country Studio Workshops Application, along with \$195 (\$150 workshop deposit and \$45 non-refundable processing fee). See the 2012 North Country Studio Workshops Application for details.
2. This Monitor Application must be mailed to: NCSW, PO Box 247, North Hampton, NH 03862. The envelope must be postmarked no later than **September 1, 2011**.

Applicants will be notified by North Country Studio Workshops on or before September 15, 2011.
