



KIRA FOURNIER SCHOLARSHIP

THE KIRA FOURNIER SCHOLARSHIP provides financial support to an established studio artist in order to promote his/her artistic growth. Established by Benjamin Schore in memory of his late wife, an innovative New Hampshire artist who died in 2002, the scholarship provides a grant of \$860 to cover tuition and room and board for North Country Studio Workshops 2012.

KIRA FOURNIER'S STORY



Kira first came to prominence as an artist in the late 1970s, when she started making ceramic cooking vessels on an ancient Chinese prototype she had learned about while a student at Goddard College in Vermont. Her pots, first used at a well-known restaurant, were later marketed nationally. In the early 1990s, seeking further artistic challenge, Kira enrolled at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston and at Alfred University. In 1997, Kira attended North Country Studio Workshops for a glass workshop that sparked a change in her life. She was inspired to enroll in an MFA program in sculptural glass at the University of Arizona that launched her career as a committed sculptor. Through her gifted work and despite illness, Kira demonstrated remarkable determination, passion and dedication to her career and to her artistic goals. Her life as an artist is an inspiration and it is in this spirit that the Kira Fournier Scholarship will allow a recipient to attend NCSW.

WHO MAY APPLY?

Craftspeople and visual artists whose resume and body of work demonstrate a strong commitment to an artistic discipline. Jurors will favor work that is modern rather than traditional and that transcends function.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. The artist's work as evidenced by work samples shows high artistic quality and a strong artistic vision. Work samples must have been completed within the last 3 years.
2. The artist's resume demonstrates perseverance and commitment to their artistic career and lists accomplishments and endeavors that have been most important to their artistic work.
3. Statement of how this scholarship would advance the artist's artistic growth in the short term and long term and the likely impact on the artist's work and future direction.

CONDITIONS

Successful applicants are asked (1) to submit a piece of their artwork to the NCSW Silent Auction fundraiser held during the Workshops and (2) to write a brief evaluation of their experience at NCSW.

PROCESS

Applicants must be registered for a workshop in order to apply for a scholarship. Workshop registration and Scholarship application materials along with \$195 (\$150 workshop deposit and \$45 non-refundable processing fee) are due by **September 1, 2011**. Mail, with your deposit, to North Country Studio Workshops, PO Box 247, North Hampton, NH 03862 or fax, using your credit card, to our registrar at 802-454-1322.

North Country Studio Workshops will notify applicants by **September 15, 2011**. Successful applicants will be reimbursed their workshop deposit, but are responsible for the workshop Material and Application Processing Fees.

In the event that NCSW is unable to award a scholarship to you, and you will not be able to participate in the workshop without financial aid, you must let us know in advance by checking the appropriate box on this application. Your \$150 tuition deposit will be returned to you. Your \$45 processing fee remains non-refundable.
